And from that hour, the disciple took her into his own [keeping, own home].</p>	Mary is the mother of Jesus
Mary, mother of God or simply a woman ?	<p>Luke 11:27-28</p> <p>[27]Now it occurred that as He was saying these things, a certain woman in the crowd raised her voice and said to Him, Blessed (happy and to be envied) is the womb that bore You and the breasts that You sucked!</p> <p>[28]But He said, Blessed (happy and to be envied) rather are those who hear the Word of God and obey and practice it!</p>	Mary is the mother of God

<p>Forbidden</p>	<p>1 Corinthians 6:9-12</p> <p>[9]Do you not know that the unrighteous and the wrongdoers will not inherit or have any share in the kingdom of God? Do not be deceived (misled): neither the impure and immoral, nor idolaters, nor adulterers, nor those who participate in homosexuality,</p> <p>[10]Nor cheats (swindlers and thieves), nor greedy graspers, nor drunkards, nor foulmouthed revilers and slanderers, nor extortioners and robbers will inherit or have any share in the kingdom of God.</p> <p>[11]And such some of you were [once].
